#### What Ails Your Dog?

As the dry grass season is upon us again, this month we'll mention that old complaint -

#### GRASS SEEDS IN THE EARS

Our dogs have very large open type of ears which present a wonderful target for these needle sharp grass seeds - but fortunately the proportion of victims is very low, as compared with smaller breeds, particularly the Spaniels.

Even so we must take the normal precautionary measures i.e. if you walk your dog through high grass where the risk is greatest, check his ears when you get him home.

One of these seeds can cause untold misery and pain to your dog if left unattended and is usually a job for the Vet. If you see your dog worrying his ear, or excessively shaking his head in discomfort - DON'T IGNORE IT something is wrong, the Vet can see the cause if you can't, he has the necessary light and instruments.

# Training Notes.

It has been noticed in the past month or so that there has been a definite falling off in attendance at Training Sessions.

While it is realized that Xmas is approaching fast and those odd jobs are claiming quite an amount of your time at weekends - it is hoped that your interest in your dog and the Club is not waning.
